Language Games

Game	Description
Flashfun	Teacher “flashes” cards and children say what it is
Find a Partner	Children must walk around the classroom calling out their item (in the target language) until they meet the other people with the same card. This could work to get children into groups for the next activity.
Mexican Wave	Each child say one word in the phrase being practiced (e.g. Je / vais / à / l'école / à / vélo).
Back Tracing	Children stand in a line up to the board (or could do this in small groups with the first person having a mini-wb) teacher tells person at the back of the line a letter/number which is they then trace onto the person's back in front of them and so on until it reaches the front where the child draws the letter/number on the board and says it out loud.
Dans mon sac il y a... <i>Sac can be replaced with chambre/ma maison/mon panier etc</i>	Small groups works best (3-4) Children take it in turns to add an item each time (Dans mon sac il y a une trousse... dans mon sac il y a une trousse et un cahier.... Etc)
Levez-vous si.....	Children stand up when you call out something they are wearing/ their birthday month etc
Plus/moins	Think of a number and ask class to guess it, only give the clues plus ou moins (more or less)
Odd one out	Show class four flashcards or items which are related to the same topic, partners to figure out which one is unrelated and name object (in French!) team who spot it first win a point
Jacques a dit	Simon says
“Plouf!”	Write a series of numbers on the board like stepping-stones over a river. Put children in teams. Each team has a go at a time; pupil comes to the board and reads the numbers aloud if they make a mistake the class call “plouf!” and no point. If they get across with no mistakes then the team gets a point.
Find the missing one	Teacher (or child depending on age) reads out days of the week/months/numbers and misses one (or more) out. Children write down the missing one or put their hand up when they know
Vrai/faux	True or false. Pictures on the board. Teacher (or children depending on level) makes a statement about the picture, children to decide whether it is true or false
Morpion	Noughts & Crosses, you can use this for any topic. Put pictures of learning topic in each space and children play by telling you which picture they want their O or X on.
Scrabble	Teacher starts with word in large grid on the board. Children in teams. Each team takes a turn to add a word to the grid
Timing game	Split class into two teams (sit in circles). Teacher to pick a question and ask first child in the circle who answers (for example Quel âge as-tu? J'ai dix ans) children then passes the same question to the next person who answers and then passes same question on etc until reach the end of the circle. Team with the lowest time wins.
Un ou Une	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Choose 10 words learned in lesson 2 teams, all standing Teacher says a word, Pupils have to put hands up immediately; if hesitate sit down and referee with teacher Left hands up for un words, right for une Those who are wrong sit down and referee with teacher, team left with most finalists wins
Memory Game	Show children 5/6 written words (which they already know). Give them a few minutes to try to remember as many as possible. Then give them time to write down the words of slips of paper. Teacher calls out one of the words that was shown and children hold it up if they remembered. 2 points if correct spelling, 1 point if plausible spelling.
Alphabetical Picture	Pupils look at a picture with several items represented (could be shop, a room etc). Teacher asks who can name the most objects starting with... P (example)
Running Dictation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Set up 4/5 sentences around the room (stick them on a door or wall etc) Children in pairs One is the runner, one is the scribe (switch for each sentence or depending on ability) Runner has to run to a sentence, memorise it and run back to the scribe to tell them the sentence. They can do this a word at a time if that is what they need! First pair to have all 4 sentences written down ends the game. Self-assess with teacher the spelling of each word that has been written (could be really simple sentences like Il y a un chat with a picture to help for example) children get a point for each word spelt correctly This means that the team that ended the game may not automatically win!
Lotto (Bingo)	Children draw a grid 3x3 (9 squares) write down 9 numbers between 1-10 or 1-20 (whatever you are learning) Teacher calls out a number, if they have it they cross it off and the winner is the child who has all their numbers crossed off first
